
Solution: In most cases this can be repaired by re-soldering the DSP and DRAM.

Component IC19: 7E48000105 - KM416V1000CJ-5 DRAM 1MX16 and

Component IC20: 490006011 - DSP DSP56362PV120

1. Remove the lid of the product.

- 2. Examine the soldering points on the DSP and DRAM fig.1.
- 3. If you can't see anything wrong at first we recommend that you resolder them anyway because the lead-free tin-based solders are still relatively new and it can be difficult to locate cold/bad soldering point.



Note:

PTA will improve the manufacture process in the future. (it's properly because we use Lead-free soldering now, which means the process is more difficult now, and the process has to be maintained more carefully than ever before, when we used lead)
