Reason for note:

When upgrading or replacing a defective CF card from an Icon hardware MKI, you might have had a 64Mb CF card in the machine and you are now replacing it with a 1 GB CF card.

When booting for the first time you get a "Invalid or damaged bootable partition"
This is due to an old bios function called "IDE HDD AUTO DETECTION" that has to be run.

Actions:

Reboot the machine and press DEL to enter BIOS....password is ICON.

Go to the IDE HDD AUTO DETECTION and press ENTER.

Then press **ENTER** 2 times

And on secondary Master press 2 and ENTER.

Then press F10 and Y and the systems reboots and is now able to see the new CF card.
