Procedure:

- 1. TURN OFF POWER AND DISCONNECT POWER CORD.
- 2. Remove the lid and the back panel from the EQ station, you'll have to dismount the left and right rack panels.
- Remove the small metal lid from the back panel slot were the ADA card will be mounted in.
- You can mount the new card 815031011 in the top or the lower slot just be aware of if there is an ADA card mounted in the lower slot then use the 566005035 spacer otherwise use the 566034130.
 - a. If you mount the card in lower slot and there is no card above it then fasten the card with **562000040** screw.
- 5. Fasten the card using the 562000040 screw.

NOTE: If replacing an ADA card, remove the screw located in the middle of the card before removing it.

- 6. Mount the back panel and lid again
- 7. Power on the unit and make sure that the station locates the card when booting up, you should hear click sounds from the relays.
- 8. END
